



Dear Parents / Carers,

As the academic year hastens to a close, I write to thank you for the wonderful support that you continue to provide for your children.

Increases in the cost of living and a resurgence of Covid-19 have made life very difficult for many families. Despite these challenges, you have prioritised education and helped your children to attend school punctually every day. You have encouraged them to stay focused on learning so that they can achieve their ambitions. I appreciate the sacrifices that you may have made to give your children the very best chance of success.

Thank you for taking the time to complete the Star parents' survey a few weeks ago. Your opinions matter to us. I am delighted that 76% of parents' responses were positive. The vast majority of you who completed the survey reported that your children felt happy and safe in school, that high expectations prevailed and that schools offered a good range of subjects for pupils to study. Through the survey, the improvements you asked us to make were to increase the level of extra-curricular activity and to provide more support for home reading. At some schools, you asked for concerns to be dealt with more effectively. Some of you reported that you do not know who the members of the governing body are at your child's school.

We take your views very seriously and use them to help us improve. Regarding extra-curricular provision, we are planning a series of competitions and experiences linked to Star's leadership foundations: sport, creativity, performing arts, enterprise and careers, charity and social action. Our schools are also developing their work with high status partners such as the Scouts and the Duke of Edinburgh's Awards scheme to enhance their range of clubs and opportunities. Schools will include the names of governors in their newsletters and will amplify their efforts to make sure that any concerns are dealt with quickly and properly.

In the meantime, I hope that you enjoy some special family time this summer. Thank you again for your support and commitment.
