The children are working very hard to engage in reading and learning and we are so proud of them.

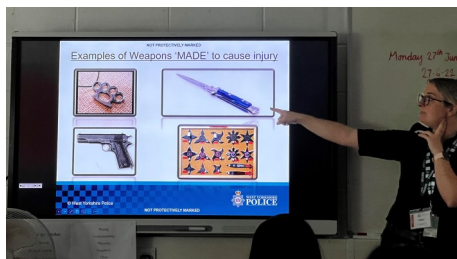
This week in cooking club, the children have made pancakes and had a delicious choice of lots of toppings... mmm delicious!
