



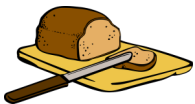
Dear Parents/Carers,

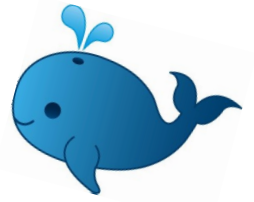
Please can we remind all parents that under no circumstances, we do NOT allow photographs to be taken of any children on the school premises. Thank you.

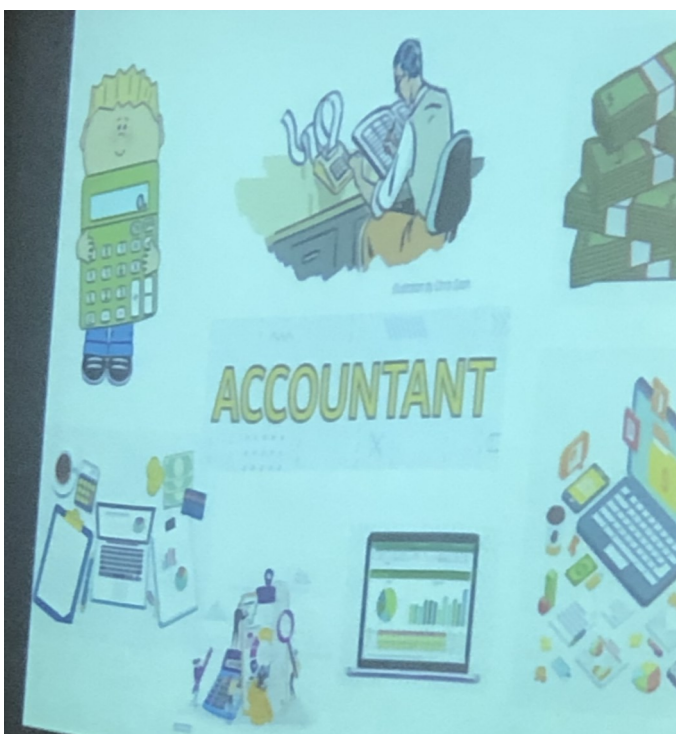


Tanzila Samun's visit to Thornbury!
