As you all may already be aware, last week on Monday 13th June, we held a lost property stall to give you all a chance to reclaim your child's lost property.

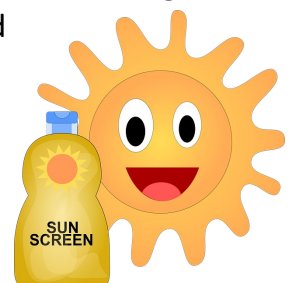
Despite this, there is still lots of clothing which hasn't been claimed. We have decided to donate these clothes to our second hand uniform provision for those less fortunate.

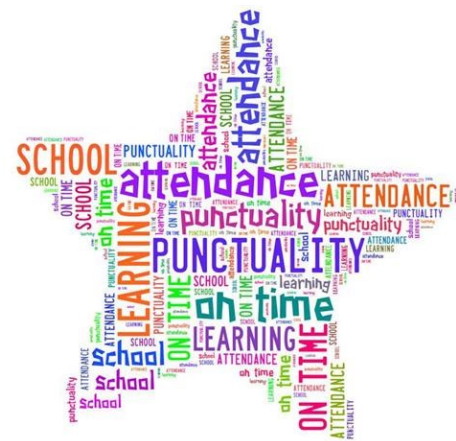

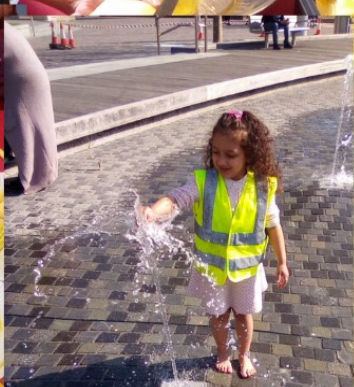
