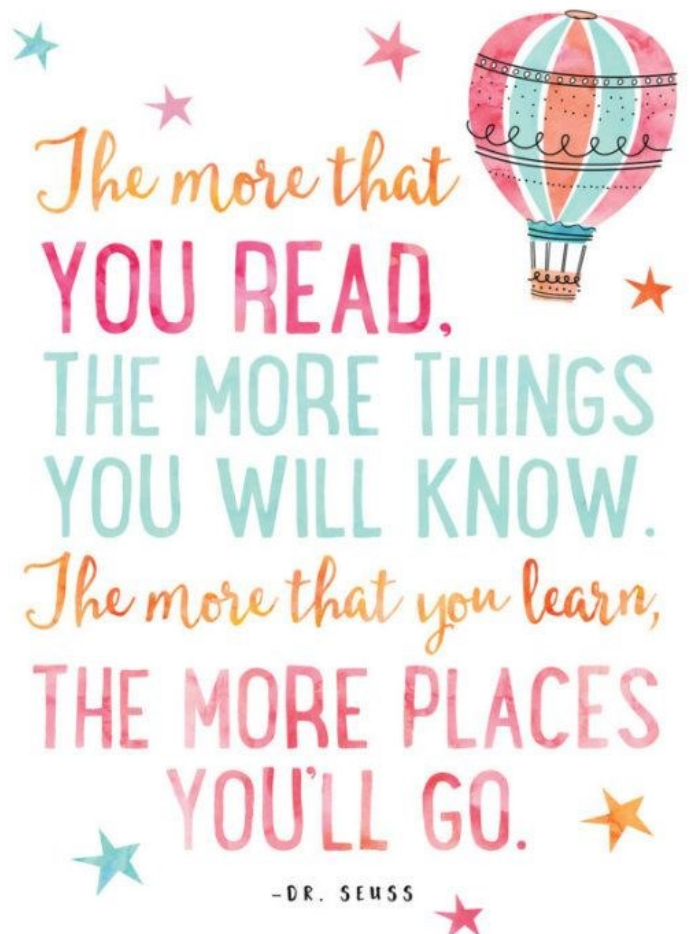

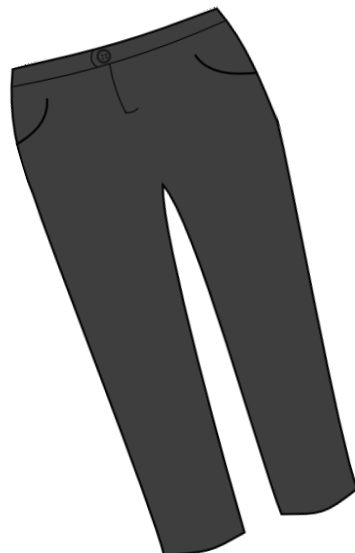


Uniform selling event (Pop up shop)

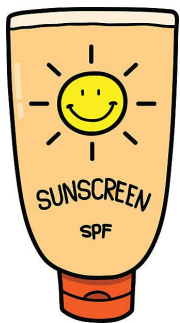


Late arrivals - SAFEGUARDING ISSUE

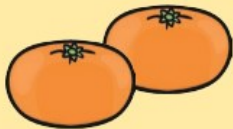

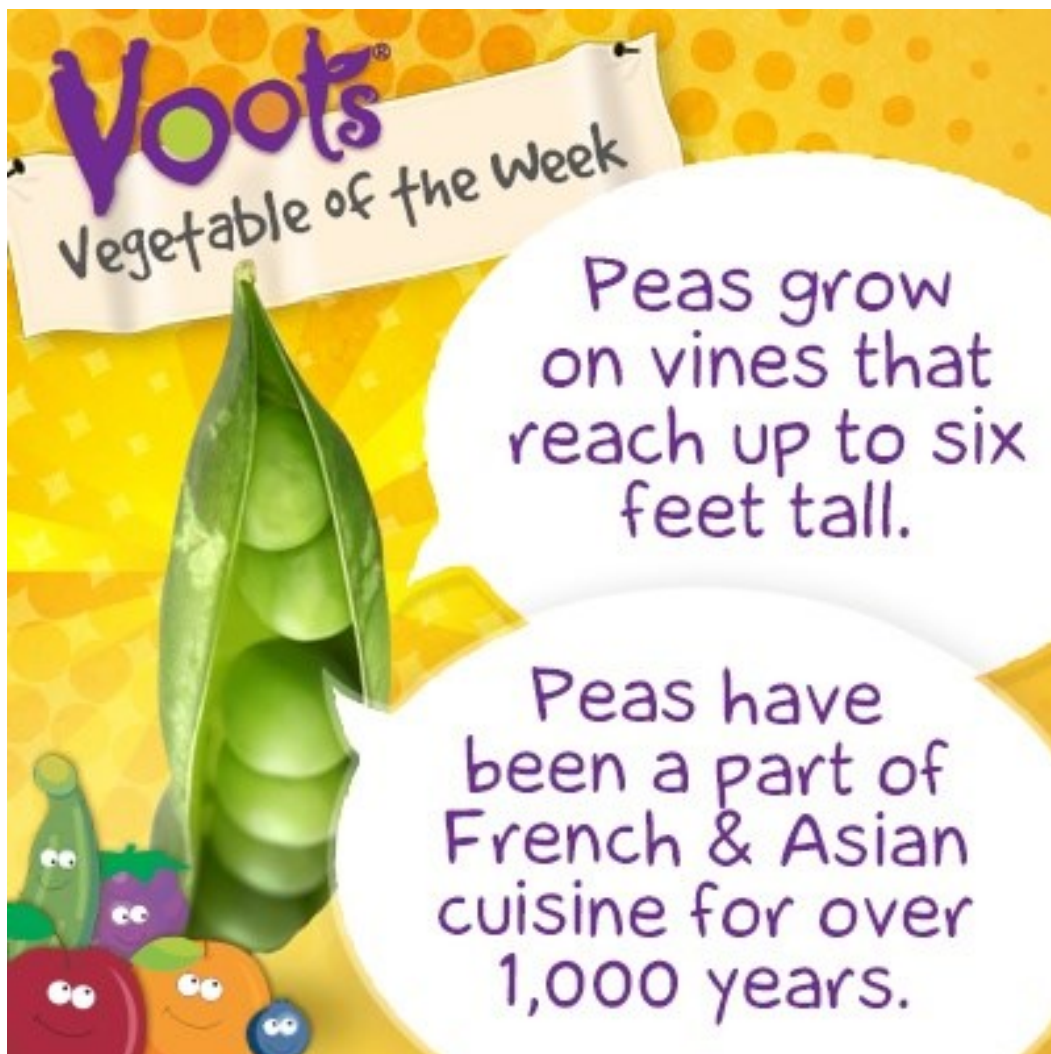

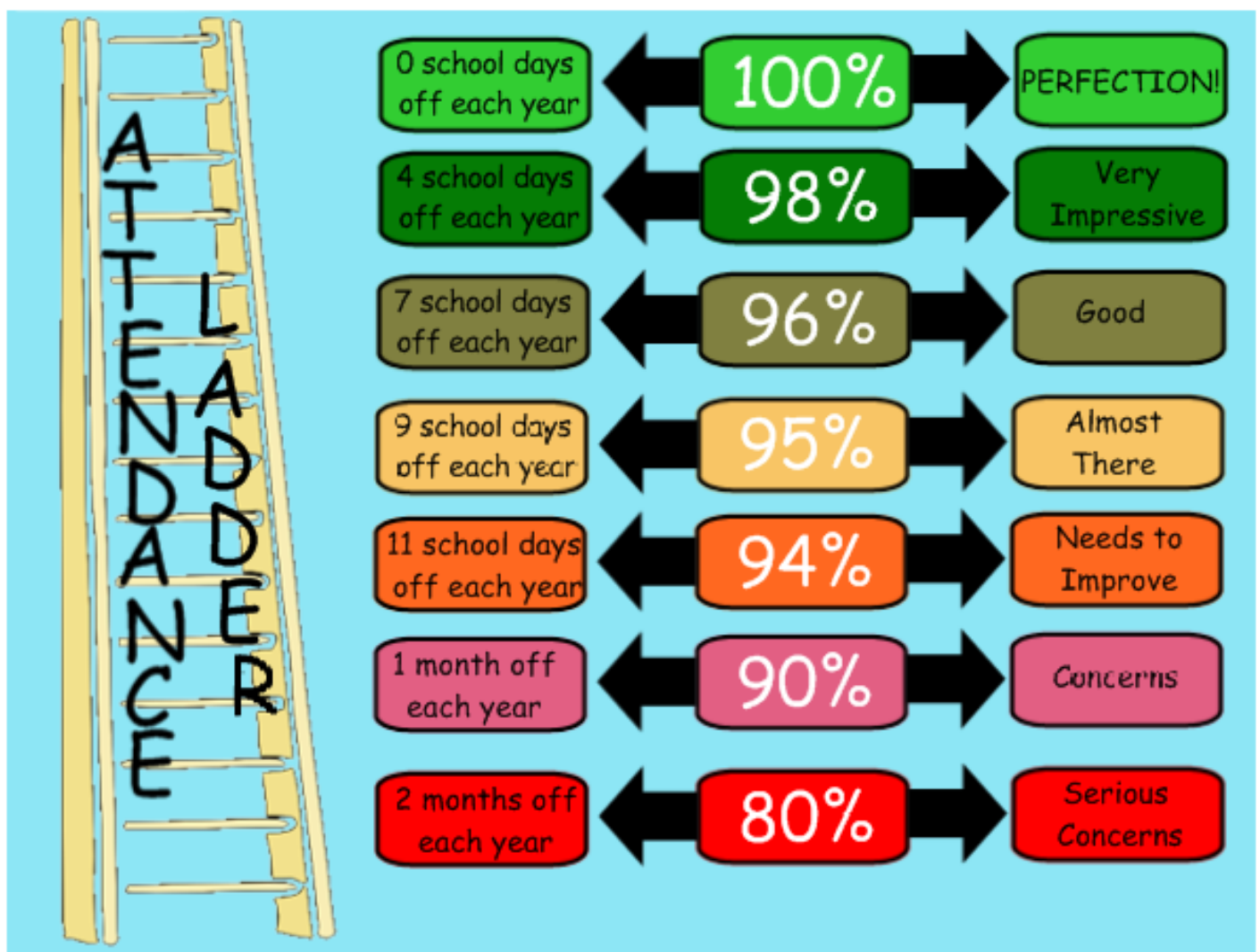
