## **NEU strike action**

As you are aware, the school has received notification from the National Education Union (NEU) trade union that its teacher members propose to take strike action in England. This action relates to a national dispute with the government about teachers' pay. The dates for strike action are:

- Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2023
- Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023

As some teaching staff within the school are members of the NEU union, the school will be affected by the strike action. For our pupils' safety and to ensure the continuity of their education, we will be implementing a number of measures to minimise the disruption to our pupils.

In order to ensure all our pupils are safe, children from the following classes **MUST NOT** attend school on these days as the classes will be closed:
